- FAFSA IS THE FINANCIAL AID FORM REQUIRED TO BE CONSIDERED FOR ALL FINANCIAL AID (NJ, INDIVIDUAL SCHOOL, AND FEDERAL), FAFSA.GOV
- > THE FAFSA FORM CAN BE COMPLETED IN THE OCTOBER OF SENIOR YEAR.
- FINANCIAL AID NIGHT IS HELD IN SEPTEMBER OR OCTOBER EACH SCHOOL YEAR FOR PARENTS AND SENIORS TO ATTEND AND HEAR A GUEST SPEAKER DISCUSS THIS PROCESS.
